Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 22nd May 2019 in Culmstock Methodist Hall at 7.00pm.

Councillors and the Clerk were introduced to all present, together with the P3 Co-ordinator and Community First Responder. The P3 Co-ordinator and Community First Responder were thanked for their voluntary work within the Parish.

The Chairman reported on the possibility of the Parish Council either leasing or purchasing the Methodist Hall following the decision made by the Methodist circuit to close the hall for services last month. The Parish Council has been discussing whether or not it would be beneficial to keep the building for the Parish for various activities/functions. Feedback is required and forms will be left at the pub and village stores – feedback may also be submitted by post, email or Facebook.
