Do you need a new home in Clayhidon, Culmstock or Hemyock? Are there people in the village unable to rent or buy a home? Have people had to move away from the village to find a suitable home?

Mid-Devon District Council and the Parish Councils would like to update information on local housing need in the parishes of Clayhidon, Culmstock and Hemyock.

The best way to do this is to carry out a Parish Housing Needs Survey.

A survey pack has been delivered to every home in the parish, but you can also complete it online at www.surveymonkey.com/r/blackdownclusterHNS or follow the QR code below.



It is really important that as many households as possible complete and return the form so that the District and Parish Councils can be given a full picture of housing needs. The information from this survey will help us to plan for the future and ensure that the correct number and size of affordable homes are built in the parishes for local people if they are needed.

The survey is being conducted by Devon Communities Together (DCT), which is an independent organisation. They will process the information, and all personal details will remain confidential.

If you know someone who has moved from the parishes of Clayhidon, Culmstock or Hemyock because they cannot afford accommodation, or what they need is not available, they can also complete the form.
